- b. Currently participating in some capacity in soccer: as a player, referee, coach, or administrator.
- c. Graduating Grade 12 student entering an accredited Canadian post-secondary institution in the fall of the high school graduating year.
- d. Minimum B average – 73% (Grades 11 and 12 year to date).
- e. Demonstrating good citizenship, character, and leadership.

 3. Personal reference letter from a family friend, coach, or teacher regarding the candidate's character and citizenship
 4. Transcript of Grade 11 and 12 marks. (Include marks to date for Grade 12)
